





General Flow


- Techniques and Tools

Initial Steps


- Notification from HR

- Confirm availability of all above



Process - High Level

User Contact


- Set up direct training
- Review corporate acceptable use standards
- Define security processes
- Provide follow up support
- Demonstrate access to self support



Non-Tech Onboarding Stuff

More important than you think

- Whose responsibility?
- Wayfaring and Directions to/from locations or buildings?
- Gender Neutral bathroom locations?
- Who to contact with questions?
- Workspace modifications? Ergonomics?
- Cafe locations? Pantries? Refrigerator?
- Where are the office supplies?
- Lactation room?
- Any special accommodations?





Zero Touch Provisioning The Holy Grail

- Drop-ship a Mac directly to the enduser
- IT does not physically touch the Mac
- Extra savings in shipping costs
- Offloads the responsibility of "setting up" the Mac to software tools and the end-user
- Sometimes not achievable regardless of what the MDM vendor says





