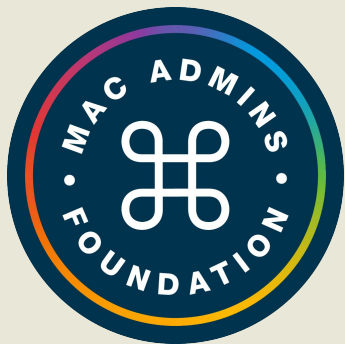

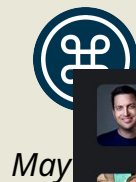

- Ventura will be much more stringent on code signing for .apps, Apple Installers, etc.
- Currently, I have an LLC (Clever DevOps Co.), which provides a code signing cert for Nudge, mainly. This is fine, but with the MAF in place, I was hoping we could figure out a more community-driven method for open source and code signing.
- The initial question was whether we could have the MAF itself get a developer account and provide a code signing cert for use by open source within the MacAdmins Github.
- As a Plan B, in order to shield the MAF itself from liability concerns, another idea was to form a new LLC with MacAdmins Github folks on the board (and MAF folks too?) to handle the purchase, maintenance and process around a new Code Signing cert for use by open source projects.

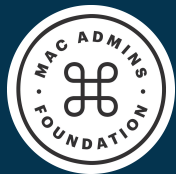

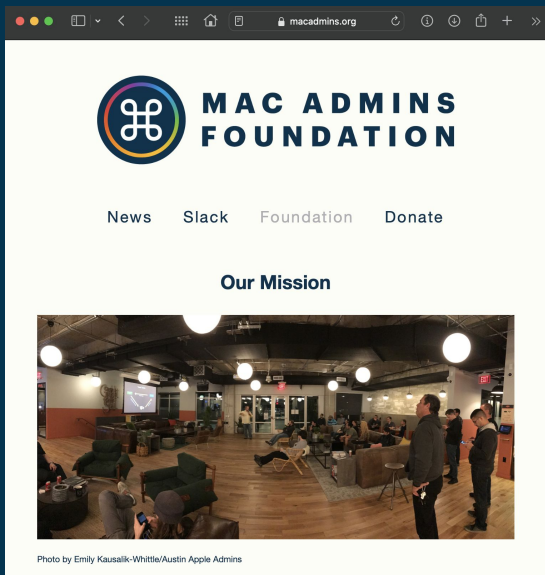
Elliot Jordan releases [Escrow Buddy](#) on the MacAdmins Github in partnership with Netflix

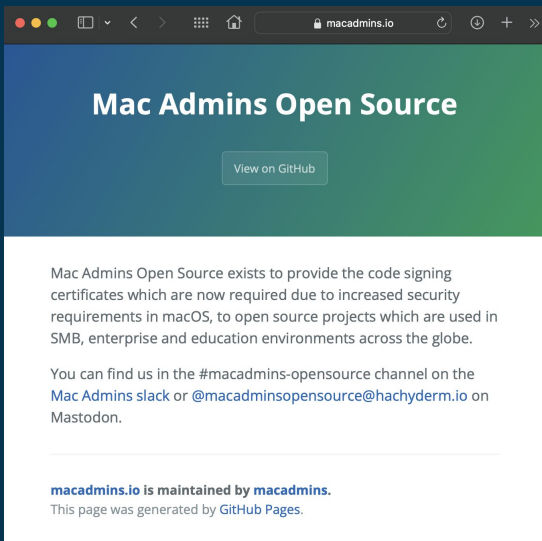

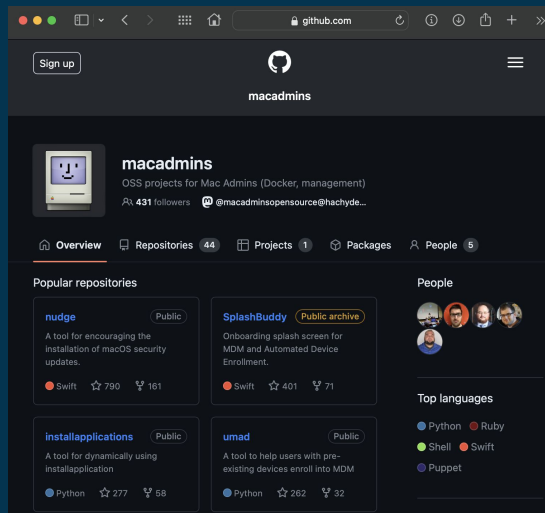

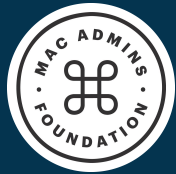
